The results of this final workshop – which concludes a series of five seminars with crisis management professionals - will be used to deliver final recommendations on decision support systems designed to facilitate the management of cascading effects in crisis.

During this workshop the **integrated PREDICT Tool Suite (iPDT) developed during the project will be presented**. This decision support system aims to enable the mitigation of the consequences of cascading effect thanks to improved situation awareness and training. Current and future challenges in the field of cascading effect management will also be discussed with the participating experts, based on the lessons learnt from the activities of the PREDICT project.

*In the last three years of the project, [CEIS](#) organised four workshops with end-users from various European crisis management bodies. In total, more than 60 end-users representing 45 national organisations and European Institutions attended one or multiple workshops, where they contributed to the research, provided input and feedback, and validated our findings.*
